SINAM (Sadayanodai Ilaignar Narpani Mandram) is a registered non-profit, non-political, non-religious organization primarily working for the sustainable empowerment of marginalized communities in Tiruvanamalai district. Established in 1986 when casteism was at its peak, and had prevented people from disadvantaged communities to exercise their basic rights, SINAM's interventions had been to educate the communities - as we believe that education is the key to unlock the opportunities laid for them. Gradually, we extended our activities to address unemployment prevailing among youth, gender violence, and environmental crisis. Through skill development, and capacity building training, we try to establish a secured future for youth as well as women. Our family counselling centre acts as an additional support to help women going through gender violence, and have helped many women come out of depression and misery. To mitigate the environmental degradation, we plant thousands of saplings each year and encourage local community to participate in this initiative. Our programmes are structured in a way to enhance the lives of downtrodden, and emphasize equality for all irrespective of their caste, class, and gender.



Our approach

SELAVIP - USA Project 2020 - Eco Houses to Lambadies women

SINAM has specially implemented a project named "Eco-friendly houses to support 25 Lambadies women with Female children especially the Widows". EcoSan Toilets were constructed along with the houses for safe and comfortable living with their children, and to lead a secure and decent lifestyle. We have completed the first phase of work by 2019-2020. In 2020-2021 we have successfully achieved the objective of providing Eco-friendly houses to 25 Lambadies Tribal women specially the widows with their children.





TANSACS — TI (Prevention & Control of HIV / AIDS in Tiruvannamalai District)

SINAM organisation collaborated with TANSACS - Tamil Nadu State Aids Control Society (which is a division of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare of the Central Government of India) for controlling the spread of HIV/AIDS, and preventing people of Tiruvannamalai from it. SINAM NGO have undertaken the responsibility of implementing this project in 6 blocks (Tiruvannamalai, Chengam, Pudhupalayam, Tandarampet, Kilpenathur, and Thurinjapuram) of Tiruvannamalai district. This "Target Intervention" programme includes HIV/ AIDS awareness generation programme through PEER education, personal protective measures, capacity development programme, and performance of street theatre on HIV/AIDS. We carry out a list of activities that ensures the welfare of sex workers, they are:

- Distribution of condoms in six blocks
- Circulation of pamphlets on HIV/AIDS
- Formation of district resource centre
- Celebration of International AIDS day programme
- Helping to get welfare board card, ration card, voter ID,

and widow pension, etc.

The majority of the people are benefitted through this programme. They were able to understand the mechanism of prevention, control, care/support, and personal protective measure.


